 Milford and Julius A. George of Mendon, all in said County
 of Worcester, and disinterested persons, Greeting.

Whereas, Samuel W. Wilcox and Hamilton C. Wilcox, both of
 Mendon, in our County of Worcester did petition the Superior
 Court, begun and holden at Worcester, within and for said
 County of Worcester, on the first Monday of September A.D. 1888,
 shewing that they are seized in fee simple and as tenants
 in common together with Helen M. Barrows of said Mendon
 and Alice J. Hall of Milford in said County, of and in cer-
 tain real estate situated in Mendon aforesaid, bounded
 and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a point on the
 westerly side of the road leading from Milford to Woon-
 socket opposite its junction with a road leading from
 said road near the residence of the late Samuel E. Wilcox
 to Bellingham: thence running Northerly by land of
 Gilbert G. Cook to corner of wall: thence Northeasterly by
 land of the heirs of Olney Cook to stakes and stones: thence
 Southeasterly by said last named land to said Milford
 and Woonsocket road: thence Southerly by said road to
 the point of departure containing about two acres of land
 with dwelling houses and other buildings standing there-
 on: also of and in certain other real estate situated in
 said Mendon bounded and described as follows, viz: Be-
 ginning at the junction of said two roads thence running
 northeasterly by said Milford and Woonsocket road to land
