

convey unto the said Nathan R. George, a certain tract or  
parcel of land situated in the Northwesterly part of said  
Mendon and bounded as follows, viz: Beginning at a stake  
and stones on the Southerly side of the Northbridge road so  
called, thence N. 27° E. 33 rods to stones on a rock; thence N.  
28 1/4° E. 52 rods to a stake and stones by the side of a wall,  
these two lines bounding on land of Frank H. Wood and  
Samuel Wood; thence on a stone wall N. 66 1/4° W. 53 rods 15  
links to a stake and stones and bounding on Grantee's land,  
thence S. 11° W. 79 rods to stake and stones on the Southerly  
side of said road and bounding on land of Edward H. Taft;  
thence Easterly on said road 33 1/2 rods to the point of beginning.  
The same being sprout land and containing by recent  
survey 22 acres 47 rods more or less. Being also the same  
premises quitclaimed to me by deed of Edward H. Taft da-  
ted June 14<sup>th</sup> 1894, and recorded with Worcester District Deed  
libro 1458, folio 224. The grantee hereby agreeing as part  
of the consideration for this deed to pay all taxes assessed  
on the granted premises for the years 1894 and 1895 and  
the grantor reserving the right at any time within nine  
months from the date of this instrument to draw his  
wood from the granted premises.

To have and  
to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and  
appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Nathan  
R. George and his heirs and assigns, to their own  
use and behoof forever. And I hereby for myself and  
my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with  
the grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am  
lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises,  
that they are free from all incumbrances, except said  
taxes, that I have good right to sell and convey the  
same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs,  
executors and administrators shall warrant and defend  
the same to the grantee and his heirs and assigns  
forever against the lawful claims and demands of all  
persons except as above. And for the consideration aforesaid  
I Emma L. Field wife of said Perley P. Field hereby release  
unto the grantee and his heirs and assigns all right  
of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises.
