I know all men by these presents that I, Charles  
E. Bond the mortgage named in a certain mort-  
gage given by William H. Tylee to Charles  
E. Bond dated April 7<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1896 and recorded with  
Worcester District Registry - Deeds, Libro 1501, Folio  
601, in consideration of Three Hundred and sixty

est which I acquired under the aforesaid mort-  
gage in or to that portion of the premises therein  
conveyed which is described as follows namely;  
A certain lot situated in said Worcester bounded  
and described as follows; commencing at a point  
on the East line of Bates Avenue 125 feet southerly  
of its intersection with the South line of Lincoln  
Street; thence South by said Bates Avenue 120 feet  
to a point; thence deflect 90° to the left Easterly 100  
feet; thence deflect 90° to the left Northerly 120 feet;  
thence deflect 90° to the left Westerly 100 feet to the  
point of beginning. Containing 12000 square feet  
of land, being lots numbered 2-3-4 and 5 on a  
plan made by O. W. Rugg. To have and to
