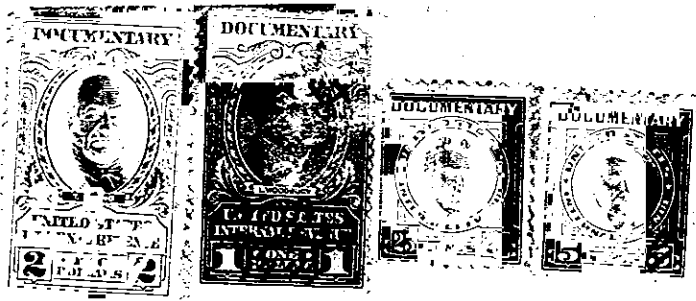

Thence S. 26° 8' E. by said Stone land three hundred sixty-eight and eight tenths (368.8) feet to a point;

Thence S. 43° 47' W. still by said Stone land, two hundred forty-nine and eight tenths (249.8) feet to a point;

Thence N. 47° 54' W. by land now or formerly of Stone, Barrows and Hardy, three hundred sixty-one and twelve hundredths (361.12) feet to land now or formerly of David F. Daley et ux.;

Thence northwesterly by said Daley land, one hundred sixty-five and fifty-two hundredths (165.52) feet to the southeasterly line of Main Street;

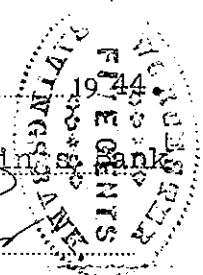
Thence northeasterly by the southeasterly line of Main Street three hundred fifty (350) feet to the point of beginning.
