PARCEL #1. A certain tract of land with all the buildings thereon, situated in Mendon in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, on the northerly side of the road leading from the County road near the house formerly of Otis Thayer to Northbridge, now called Northbridge Street, and bounded described as follows:
