A certain parcel of land together with the buildings thereon situated on the northeasterly side of the road leading from Bellingham to Mendon in said Mendon, and being all the same premises conveyed by Armando A. Calitri et ux, by deed dated October 20, 1950, and recorded in Worcester District Registry of Deeds, Book 3295, Page 43, and bounded and described in said deed as follows:

"Beginning at a stake on the northeasterly side of said Road at land now or formerly of Annie A. Jackson and others, formerly of Benjamin Bates; thence with the northeasterly side of said Road S. 59° 22' E. two hundred fifty-six and 13/100 (256.13) feet to a stake at land now or formerly of Ellis L. Jackson and others; thence turning and running S. 6° E. with said Annie A. Jackson and others land two hundred four and 51/100 (204.51) feet to the point of beginning."
