A certain parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, and all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, situated in the westerly part of said Mendon, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at the northeast corner of said parcel at a stake and stones by a ditch;

THENCE N.  $75^{\circ}$  W. 37 rods by land formerly of Nathan G. Daniels to a stake;

THENCE N.  $5^{\circ}$  W. by said Daniels land about 14 rods to a flat rock in corner of ditches;

THENCE S. 83° W. 10 rods to stake in ditch;

THENCE N.  $36\text{-}3/4^\circ$  W. on said Daniels land, 32-3/4 rods to road leading from house formerly of John C. Woods past these premises to Uxbridge (said road now known as Park Street);
