And Lastly, I do constitute & ordain my said Sons
Frederick Taft & Hannor Taft Executors of this my last
Will & Testament.

sound mind and memory, blessed be a Straightly God
for the same - do this Twelfth day of July Anno Domini
one thousand, eight hundred and sixteen, make
and publish this my last Will & Testament in manner
following, that is to w^t -

I will and order that all my just Debts that I may
be owing to any Person or Persons shall be paid in conve-
nient time after my decease.

I give to my beloved Wife Lydia Taft the use of one
half of all my silver movables, also one half of all the
Land I do seized and possessed - during her life with one
half of the Breeditings standing on the same - and in case
my two Daughters Sophia and Polly, single women -
should survive their Mother and remain single and
unmarried, or either of them to have the best room
and a Garden spot to raise Sauce for a home so long
as they or either of them remain single & unmarried.

My Willing & approved I give to my four Sons to be
equally divided between them.

I give, bequeath and devise to my well beloved
