As it is remembered that I Thomas Galt of Madison in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do on this twenty ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three make public and declare the following instrument to be a codicil and a part of my will, dated June 21<sup>st</sup> 1858 in manner following that is to say:

I give and bequeath to each of my four daughters to wit Hannah Nelson wife of Ote Nelson, Elizabeth Adams wife of Samuel Adams Henry Ann Galt and Susan Galt the sum of seven hundred dollars each to be paid them one half part thereof at my decease if I leave a widow, and the remaining half part at the decease of my widow - and in case I shall leave no widow the whole of said bequest shall be paid to each of my said daughters at my decease.

The provisions above made my said daughters are in lieu of the four hundred dollars given each of them in my will above referred to and my intention is to increase hereby their several bequest to seven hundred dollars each instead of four hundred dollars named in said will.

Luther Woodbury

I now all men by these presents that I Luther Woodbury of Millisborough Town of Sutton, in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts do make and publish this my last will.

I give bequeath and direct my estate and property as follows to wit:

I Within three months after my decease or as soon thereafter as possible I direct that a suitable monument be erected at the grave of myself wife and children at a cost of not less than one hundred and fifty dollars the same to be paid for out of my estate.

II I direct that the sum of one hundred dollars be paid to my brother in law Nelson Little of the State of Maine, provided he survive me; otherwise this bequest is to be void and of no effect.

III I give and bequeath to my sister Sarah C. Southgate of Millbury Mass. the sum of one thousand dollars, out of the amount that will be due on my life insurance policy, issued by the Union Mutual Life Insurance Company.

IV I give and bequeath to my sister in law Mrs. Nancy Anderson of said Millisborough, or in case she shall not survive me, to her niece the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars.

V I give and bequeath to my nephew Jonathan Howard of Sutton Mass. the sum of three hundred dollars - or in case he shall not survive me the above sum is to be equally divided among his surviving children.

VI I give and bequeath to Miss Louisa C. Howard of Sutton Mass. the sum of fifty dollars in grateful remembrance of her kindness to my late wife during her last sickness.

VII I give and bequeath to my nephew Daniel Good in Anderson, all my stock of goods in retail trade, and in store for said trade, together with all claims in book account, in bill and other form, against all persons, for goods sold in said trade, with the condition and provision, that the said Daniel Good shall pay all outstanding claims against me, for goods, rents, storage, freight, and services for said retail trade.

VIII I direct that all expenses of my last sickness, funeral expenses and the expenses in preparing and erecting the monument aforesaid, shall be paid from the amount which shall be due on my said life insurance policy, and the residue if any, after paying the said expenses, and the legacy to the said Sarah C. Southgate, I give and bequeath in equal shares to my niece Louisa and Amalia Southgate of Millbury Mass.
