Know all men by these presents that I Luke Aldrich Jr. of Mendon in the County of Worcester and State of Massachusetts yeoman in consideration of two thousand five hundred dollars to me well and truly paid by Scammell Aldrich of said Mendon also yeoman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Scammell Aldrich his heirs and assigns forever one undivided moiety or half part of the mesuage or homestead farm whereon my father Luke Aldrich lived last before his decease situated in Mendon aforesaid and bounded and described as follows viz. beginning at a Northwest corner of said farm or mesuage on the road leading from the village at Moonsuckat Falls to the North Parish of Mendon aforesaid and at a corner of other land now owned by the said Luke Aldrich Jr. thence Easterly with land of the said Luke to another
