and Hartford turnpike eight rods and thirteen links: thence
turning and running Easterly by and with said County road
to a stake by the side of the well at a corner of land of said
Newhall eight rods and thirteen links: thence turning and run
ning Northerly bounding Easterly on land of said Newhall
to the first mentioned bound four rods and sixteen links
