Clark Ellis, of Milford, in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Esquire, in consideration of the sum of One-hundred and sixty dollars, paid to me by William Babcock of Berlin, in the said County of Worcester, by whom, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby grant, sell and quit-claim, unto the said William Babcock, his heirs and assigns, all the right, title and claim and demand, in and unto a certain tract or parcel of land, it being pasture and meadow, situated in westerly part of Berlin, in said County of Worcester, containing sixteen acres, be it the same more or less, and for a more particular description of said premises reference being had to a deed from William Gilfe to Philo M. Ellis, dated August - 16 - 1838, and recorded in the Register of Deeds, for said County - Book 340 - Page 217 -

" To have and to hold the same to the said William Babcock, his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever.
