Mitaly in said Mendon to the county road (formerly the Boston and Hartford turnpike) opposite the house of Mary M. Hayward and bounded as follows viz: beginning at a point upon the Southwesterly side of said road at a corner of land of Thomas McAlles. thence by and with said road to the stone guide post as it now stands. thence turning and running easterly to the middle of the house on said premises opposite the partition between the two tenements thence by and with the middle of said partition through said house to the easterly side thereof. thence continuing in the same direction and in a straight line to the land of the aforesaid Thomas McAlles. thence turning and running Northwesterly bounding easterly on land of said McAlles in a straight line to the first mentioned bound at the place of beginning. the said Nancy reserving the use of the Southernmost privy standing on the premises hereby conveyed and of the well.

To Have and to Hold the above released premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Robert Mullis and his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever.
