

4 links, thence North $70^{\circ}14'$ East 5 rods to a stake and stones at land belonging to the heirs of Caleb Hayward deceased, the three last mentioned lines bounding on land of Thomas Gardner; thence North 67° East 80 rods to stones on a large stump, bounding Northerly on land of the heirs of Caleb Hayward aforesaid; thence South $12^{\circ}36'$ East 50 rods and 13 links to a heap of stones; thence North $71^{\circ}34'$ East 5 rods and 13 links to end of wall at Ariel Cook's land; the two last lines bounding on land formerly of Aaron C. Cook deceased; thence South 16° East 10 rods and 6 links to stones on a walnut stump; thence North 83° East 83 rods and 6 links crossing said Tomuck old road to the East side of it; the two last lines bounding on land of Ariel Cook aforesaid; thence North 57° East 22 rods and 10 links; thence North $65^{\circ}12'$ East 18 rods on the Easterly side of the said Tomuck old road; thence North 18° West 11 rods crossing said Tomuck old road to a corner of wall; thence North 76° East 11 rods and 3 links to a turn; thence North 72° East 7 rods to a turn; thence North 78° East 10 rods to the first mentioned bound. The four last lines bounding on land of Ariel Cook aforesaid. Also one other tract of land lying upon the Easterly side of said first mentioned road; (the tract above described lying wholly upon the Westerly side of said road) Lotted and bounded as follows, viz: Beginning at an abutment of a wall at land formerly owned by Asa Chilson, deceased, on the Easterly side of the road leading from Mendon to Providence R. I. thence Southeasterly by and with said road to the centre of Quickstream Brook; thence Easterly by and with said Brook until it comes to the road at the stone arched bridge; thence Northerly by and with said last mentioned road until it comes to the Southeasterly corner of the Necropolis; thence turning and running Westerly by and with the Southern line of said Necropolis to a corner; thence turning and running Northerly by and with the Western line of said Necropolis until it comes to the road leading from the last mentioned road to Medway and Boston; thence turning and running Westerly as the road now runs until it comes to the land of Willard H. Swan at a corner; thence continuing Westerly in a straight line to the bound first mentioned. Reserving to Willard Wilcox his heirs and assigns the right to pass and repass over and upon a part of the above premises to a wood lot conveyed by me to said Wilcox, as set forth in my deed to him. To have and to hold the granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances there-
