Davenport's dwellinghouse to Hopedale, called the Salt Box road; thence N. $34\frac{1}{2}$ W. ninety four rods; thence N. $22\frac{1}{2}$ W. thirty one rods eleven links to the road leading from the City Mills in Milford to Mendon, the two lines last described run by land formerly of Seth T.
