 to Marshall & Co. Davenport of Mendon, State of Massachusetts
 Joseph Scriven in consideration of Fifteen Hundred and Thirty five Dollars
 paid by Joseph Scriven of said Mendon, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell
 and convey unto the said Joseph Scriven, a certain tract
 or parcel of land situated in said Mendon, containing
 fifty nine and one half acres more or less, bounded as
 follows, viz: Beginning at the southeasterly corner in the
 centre of the old road leading from Seth T. Davenport's
 dwelling house to Hopedale, called the Salt Box road;
 thence N. 34¹/₂° W. 94 rods; thence N. 22¹/₂° W. 31 rods 11 links
 to the road leading from the City Mills in Milford to Men-
 don: the two lines last described run by land formerly
 of Seth T. Davenport as the wall now stands: thence Westerly
 with the centre of the said last named road, to land lately
 of Alexander Thayer deceased: thence S. 33³/₄° E. 46 rods 18 links
 thence S. 23° E. 26 rods 10 links, and same course 12 rods 5 links
 thence S. 24⁴/₅° E. 7 rods 18 links: thence S. 20° E. 3 rods 16
 links: thence S. 15⁵/₂° E. 24 rods 20 links to land formerly of
 said Seth T. Davenport, bounding Westerly on the last six
 lines by said Thayer's land as the wall and fences stand
 thence N. 67¹/₂° E. 9 rods 10 links: thence S. 43° E. 12 rods to said
 first named road: thence Northeasterly with the centre of
