

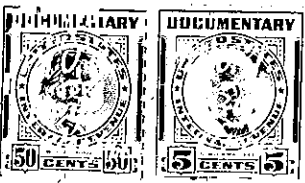
I, MOSES U. GASKILL, married,

Beginning at an iron pipe on the easterly side of Providence Street at Willow Brook, so called, thence southerly along said Providence Street to an iron pipe at land of this grantee, thence easterly by said grantee's land 150 feet to an iron pipe, thence southerly 100 feet by this grantee's land to an iron pipe at land of the grantor, thence easterly 303 feet more or less along line of an old stone wall to an iron pipe on Gaskill Street, thence northerly on Gaskill Street to Willow Brook, thence westerly by said Willow Brook to the point of beginning.
