

I, MARY E. TRASK, widow, of Mendon, Worcester County, Massachusetts, for consideration paid, grant to DONALD A. VARNEY, of Bellingham, Norfolk County and said Commonwealth of Massachusetts with

Q U I T C L A I M C O V E N A N T S

a certain tract of land containing $59\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, including all buildings thereon, situated in said Mendon, and being all the same premises conveyed by Maria Scriven to Joseph Northrop, by deed dated May 13, 1905, recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 1811, page 159, and bounded and described in said deed as follows, to wit:-

"Beginning at the South-easterly corner in the centre of the old road leading from Seth F. Davenports dwelling house to Hopedale, called the Salt Box road, thence N. $34\frac{1}{2}$ degrees W. 94 rods; thence N. $22\frac{1}{2}$ degrees W. 31 rods 11 links to the road leading from the City Mills in Milford to Mendon, the two lines last described run by land formerly of Seth T. Davenport as the wall now stands; thence Westerly with the centre of the said last named road, to land formerly of Alexander Thayer deceased; thence S. $33\frac{3}{4}$ degrees E. 46 rods 18 links; thence S. 23 degrees E. 26 rods 10 links, and same course 12 rods 5 links; thence S. $24\frac{4}{5}$ degrees E. 7 rods 18 links; thence S. 20 degrees E. 3 rods 16 links; thence S. $15\frac{5}{12}$ degrees E. 24 rods 20 links to land formerly of said Seth T. Davenport, bounding Westerly on the last six lines by said Thayer land as the wall and fences now stand; thence N. $67\frac{1}{2}$ degrees E. 9 rods 10 links, thence S. 43 degrees E. 12 rods to said first mentioned road; thence North-easterly with the centre of said road to the point of departure."

Meaning and intending to hereby convey any and all the same premises as were conveyed to this grantor by deed of Mary H. Northrop dated July 20, 1918 and recorded in Worcester District Registry of Deeds, Book 2158, page 155.
