I Know Ye, That Ephraim Taft of Mendon in the County
of Worcester & Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New
England Yeoman —

For and in Consideration of the Sum of Two hundred and Sixty five pounds lawful Money
tome in Hand before the Ensealing hereof, well and truly paid by Solomon Smith of Springfield
in the County of Providence and Colony of Rhode Island in Providence,
the Receipt whereof do hereby acknowledge, and my self therewith fully satisfied and
contented; and thereof, and of every Part and Parcel thereof, do exonerate, acquit and discharge
him the said Solomon Smith his
Heirs, Executors and Administrators, forever by these Presents: HAVE given, granted, bargained, sold,
aliened, conveyed and confirmed; and by these Presents, Do freely, fully and absolutely give, grant,
bargain, sell, alienae, convey and confirm, unto him the said Solomon Smith his
Heirs and Assigns forever, a certain Tract or parcel of land situate
and being in Mendon aforesaid containing by estimation Sixty
Acres of land & is bounded as followeth Southwesterly On land of
Turner Aldrich & Westerly partly on land of Nathan Aldrich & part
On land of Comfort Aldrich & is bounded Northwesterly part on
land of James Aldrich & part on land of George Aldrich &
is Bounded Eastwesterly partly on land of said George Aldrich
and part on land of Nathan Aldrich, Monat's Aldrich's land
with all the Privileges allowed to the same aforesaid in
the Division of the Land of David Taft Deed as by the Cogn-
other Returns of said land may appear Except what Land
the Grantor sold to Nathan Aldrich & George Aldrich which
is Not Included in this Deed —

To have and to hold the said granted and bargained Premises, with all the Appur-
tenances, Privileges and Commodities to the same belonging, or in any wise appertaining, to him
the said Solomon Smith his
Heirs and Assigns forever. To him and his only proper Use, Benefit and Behoof forever.
And I the said Ephraim Taft for myself
for Heirs, Executors and Administrators, do Covenant, Promise and Grant to and with
him the said Solomon Smith his

Heirs and Assigns, that before the Ensealing hereof, I am the true, sole and lawful Owner of the
above-bargained Premises, and lawfully seized and possessed of the same in my own proper
Right, as a good, perfect and absolute Estate of Inheritance in Fee Simple: And have in myself
good Right, full Power and lawful Authority, to grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm said bargained
Premises in Manner as aforesaid: And that the said Solomon Smith

his Heirs and Assigns, shall and may from Time to Time, and at all Times forever hereafter, by Force and
Virtue of these Presents, lawfully, peaceably and quietly Have, Hold, Use, Occupy, Possess and Enjoy
the said demised and bargained Premises, with the Appurtenances, free and clear, and freely and clearly
acquitted, exonerated and discharged of, from all and all Manner of former or other Gifts, Grants,
Bargains, Sales, Leafes, Mortgages, Wills, Entails, Jointures, Dowries, Judgments, Executions, or Incum-
brances of what Name or Nature soever, that might in any Measure or Degree obstruct or make Void
this present Deed.

Furthermore, We the said Ephraim Taft & Hannah Taft his
Wife for our selves and our Heirs,

Executors and Administrators, do Covenant and Engage the above-demised Premises to him the said
Solomon Smith his Heirs and Assigns,
against the lawful Claims or Demands of any Person or Persons whatsoever, forever hereafter to
Warrant, Secure and Defend by these Presents. In witness Whereof we the said Ephraim
