fully, and absolutely, Give, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Alien, Convey, and Confirm, unto him the said Nathan Verry his

Heirs and Assigns forever. A certain tract

of land situate lying and being in Mendon aforesaid containing by estimation twenty
seven Acres and an half by the same more or less being part of the Estate which was
formerly John Sonford of Mendon aforesaid deceased Land which I bought of Calvin
Smith of Mendon aforesaid lying near muddy brook, so called, bounded & bounded as fol-
loweth viz. beginning at a Maple tree adjoining land of William French of
Mendon aforesaid at the aforesaid Muddy brook so called then running westerly in
a straight line adjoining land of William French aforesaid as the fence now stands,
to heap of stones on a Rock; then turning & running northerly adjoining land of
John Crooks to a heap of stones on a Rock then turning and running westward adjoin-

full Power, and lawful Authority, to Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey, and Confirm, said bargained Premises, in Manner as aforesaid:
And that the said Nathan Verry his —

Heirs, and Assigns, shall and

may, from Time to Time, and at all Times forever hereafter, by Force and Virtue of these Presents, lawfully, peaceably, and quietly,
Have, Hold, Use, Occupy, Possess, and Enjoy, the said demised and bargained Premises, with the Appurtenances, free and clear, and
freely and clearly, acquitted, exonerated, and discharged of, from all and all Manner of former or other Gifts, Grants, Bargains,
Sales, Leases, Mortgages, Wills, Entails, Jointures, Dowries, Judgments, Executions, or Incumbrances, of what Name or Nature
soever, that might in any Measure or Degree obstruct or make Void this present Deed.

Furthermore, I the said William Thayer —
for my self my Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, do Covenant and Engage the above demised Premises to him
the said Nathan Verry his —
Heirs and Assigns, against the lawful Claims or Demands of any Person or Persons whatsoever, forever hereafter to Warrant, Secure
and Defend by these Presents,
