I know all men by these presents that I David Moore of Worcester in the County of Worcester of yeoman in consideration of eight hundred dollars paid by Nathan Waiter Jr of Leominster in said County Yeoman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Nathan Waiter Jr his heirs and assigns a tract of land with the Buildings thereon lying in said Worcester on the north side of the County road leading from Worcester to Hardwick bounded east on said Waiter land north on John Davis Esq's East on the new County road leading from Paxton to Rutland and on the south by the said Hardwick road containing about seventy acres to be the same more or less —

To have and to hold the same to the said Nathan Waiter Jr his heirs and assigns to his and their behoof forever and I do covenant with the said Nathan Waiter Jr his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises that they are free of all incumbrances and that I will warrant and defend the same to the said Nathan Waiter Jr his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons —

Provided nevertheless in case the said David Moore his heirs Executors or Administrators shall and do well and truly pay to the said Nathan Waiter Jr his heirs and assigns the sum of eight hundred dollars within one year from the date hereof with interest annually until paid agreeably to his note of hand of even date herewith given to the said Nathan for the same sum and interest then this deed is to be void otherwise to abide in full force —
