tion of the sum of two thousand and eighty four dollars and
forty nine cents paid me by Israel Thordike of Boston in
the County of Suffolk Esquire the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged do hereby give grant assign transfer & set
over to the said Thordike his heirs and assigns forever the
said undivided one half of the foregoing described premises
and parcels of land with all their privileges and appurten-
ances — To have and to hold the same to him the said
Thordike his heirs and assigns to his and their use & behoof
forever as fully and amply as I the said Asa my heirs or
assigns might hold & enjoy the same by virtue of the fore-
going Mortgage the said Thordike his heirs Executors
and Administrators performing the conditions & covenants
therein of me required and I do for my self my heirs Executors
and administrators hereby authorize & empower the said
Thordike his heirs Executors and Administrators to receive
to his and their own use the sum mentioned in the con-
dition of said Mortgage and to discharge the said mortgage
as fully as I could have done if this assignment had not
been made and I do for my self my heirs Executors and
administrators covenant with the said Thordike
his heirs and assigns that I have good right to assign
the said premises as aforesaid (subject however to the
right of Redemption as by law in such cases is provided)
against the lawful claims of all persons — In witness
of which I the said Asa Waters have hereunto set my hand
and seal this fifteenth day of December in the year of our
Lord Eighteen hundred and fourteen — Asa Waters (Seal)
