The third piece is partly meadow and partly upland having a dwelling House standing thereon containing about eight Acres bounded Northerly on Nahum Wheelock's land westerly and Southerly on Lebbus Daniels Land and Easterly on a town road with all the privileges and appurtenances to all the lands belonging — To have and to hold the aforesaid premises to the said Anson Aldrich his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever and I do covenant with the said Anson Aldrich that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises, that they are free of all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Anson Aldrich his heirs and assigns and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Anson Aldrich his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons — In witness whereof I the said Ebenezer Aldrich have hereunto set my hand and seal the seventh day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two
