

Aldrich Anson Know all men by these presents, that Anson Aldrich of Mendon in the County of Worcester  
 to Commonwealth of Massachusetts, yeoman, in consideration of the sum of four thousand  
 Ebenezer Aldrich dollars paid me by Ebenezer Aldrich of the same Mendon, yeoman, the receipt whereof  
 I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby sell & convey unto the said Ebenezer Aldrich, the three  
 following described parcels or tracts of land, with all the buildings thereon standing,  
 & all the privileges & appurtenances therunto belonging, viz, the first piece is situated on  
 Quisset hill, so called, in said Mendon, containing, by estimation, eighty eight acres,  
 be the same, more or less, bounded Westerly on the green tree land, Northerly on a town  
 road & on land formerly belonging to Nahum Wheelock, now deceased, & Easterly & Southerly  
 partly on Winsor or Wheelocks & partly on Moses Daniels land — The second piece is a new  
 lot, situated near Caleb's hill, so called, in said Mendon, containing twenty acres, be the  
 same more or less, bounded Easterly partly on the grantors land & partly on Adolphus Daniels  
 land, Northerly on Andrew Penniman's land, Westerly on Mary Allen's land, & Southerly on  
 Ariel Cooks land — The third piece is partly meadow & partly upland, having a dwelling  
 house standing thereon, containing about eight acres, bounded Northerly on land former  
 Nahum Wheelock's, deceased, Westerly & Southerly on land set off to the creditors of Gibbens  
 Daniels, & Easterly on a town road; the said three tracts or pieces of land, being the same  
 that the said Ebenezer Aldrich, conveyed by deed to the said Anson Aldrich on the

 Aldrich, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises; that they are free  
 of all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell & convey the same to the said Ebenezer  
 Aldrich, his heirs & assigns, & that I will warrant & defend the same premises to the said  
 Ebenezer Aldrich, his heirs & assigns forever, against the lawful claims & demands of  
 all persons — In witness whereof, I the said Anson Aldrich, & Lydia Aldrich,  
 wife of the said Anson Aldrich; in witness of quitting my right of dower or thirds  
 in the premises have herunto set our hands & seals this twentieth day of April in the  
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty seven — Anson Aldrich (seal)

 to Worcester Esquire, in consideration of three hundred dollars paid by Abijah Bigelow of  
 Abijah Bigelow Worcester aforesaid, Esquire, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give,  
 grant, sell & convey unto the said Abijah Bigelow, his heirs & assigns forever, an  
 undivided half of the following tract of land situate in said Worcester, back of the  
 County house of correction, containing about six acres & an half, bounded, begin-  
 ning at the Northwest corner of said tract of land & runs South, seventy five degrees  
 East thirty nine rods & an half of a rod by a lane; then South thirty four & an half  
 degrees West five rods & nine links, then South twenty degrees West twenty four
