Know all men by these presents that I, Allen Aldrich of Mendon County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts Gentleman in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars to me paid by Carlisle W. Capron of the same Mendon Gentleman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Carlisle W. Capron his heirs and assigns forever A certain tract of woodland situated in said Mendon in the South woods so called containing by estimation ten acres more or less & bounded as follows Viz Beginning at the South west corner of the premises; thence N 4 1/2 W, 80 rods to a stake and stone to the North west corner of the premises & bounding Westerty on land that Alexander Thayer this day conveyed to the Grantee; thence N 87 1/2 E 5 rods & 9 links; thence N 78 1/2 E, 14 rods; thence S 74 1/2 E, 8 rods; thence N 80 1/2 E, 6 1/2 rods to a heap of stones at the Northeast corner of the premises. the four last lines are on land of Nathan C. Aldrich; thence turning & running S 9 1/4 W, 35 rods to a large stone; thence S 68 1/2 W, 18 rods to a stake & stone; thence S 8 1/2 E, 39 rods & 10 links to a heap of stones by wall & to the Southeast corner of the premises; thence turning and running S 87 1/2 W, 11 rods & 23 links to a heap of stones to the first mentioned bounds & bounding Easterly and Southerly on the Grantee's land, being the same wood that the Grantor purchased of Sumner Ballou. To have and to hold the above granted premises to the said Carlisle W. Capron his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever And I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Carlisle W. Capron his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seised in fee of the above granted premises; that they are free of all incumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Carlisle W. Capron And that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Carlisle W. Capron his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
