I know all men by these presents that I the within named Anson Aldrich in consideration of five hundred and sixty three dollars and twenty cents to me paid by Riley Daniels of Mendon in said County of Worcester yeoman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby grant assign release and convey unto the said Riley Daniels the premises within conveyed to me in mortgage and all my right title interest and estate in and unto the same - To have and to hold the same to the said Riley Daniels his heirs and assigns to his and their sole use behoof forever and I the said Anson Aldrich for my self my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Riley Daniels his heirs assigns and administrators that the premises are free from all incumbrances (the proviso within contained for the redemption of the same only excepted) that I will and my heirs &c. shall warrant and defend the same to the said Riley Daniels his heirs and assigns against all persons and that I will and my heirs and executors & administrators shall execute and acknowledge any further assurances for the better conveying and assigning the premises to the said Riley Daniels his heirs and assigns when tendered for that purpose which he or they may reasonably require the said Aldrich does not warrant & defend against any right to dower in the premises which the wife of said Pratt may hereafter have -

Cambridge of Mount Vernon in the County of Hillsborough & State of New Hampshire yeoman in consideration of sixty nine dollars & twenty seven cents paid me by Barthimus Tenney of Linnester in the County of Worcester Commonwealth of Massachusetts yeoman the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby grant sell and quit claim unto the said Barthimus Tenney his heirs and assigns all my right title claim and demand in and unto a certain piece of land situated in the northerly part of said Linnester on the south side of the road leading from the "Scar" so called to the village Mills bounded beginning at a Stake & Stones by land of Amos Hears & runs easterly by said road six rods to a Stake & Stones thence south 10° east nine rods & 19 links to a Stake & Stones thence south 75° west six rods to a Stake & Stones thence north 10° west ten rods & seven links to the first bounds the two last lines being on land of said Hears said premises were a part of the homestead of Benjamin & Joseph & were set off to me by virtue of an execution in my favor against said Joseph -
