 an the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give grant sell and convey  
 unto the said Ariel Cook 2<sup>d</sup> his heirs and assigns A certain tract or parcel of  
 Lands lying in Mendon aforesaid on the easterly side of the County Road  
 leading from Worcester to Providence containing thirty acres be the same  
 more or less bounding as follows Viz. beginning at the North West corner  
 at the road aforesaid at Thomas Wheelock's Land thence Easterly and  
 bounding Northwesterly on said Thomas and Andrews Wheelock's Land to  
 Mill River (so called) thence down stream of said River until it comes  
 to lands belonging to the heirs of Moses Daniels late of Mendon dec'd  
 thence Westerly and bounding southerly on lands of said Daniels <sup>deceased</sup> to  
 the grantee's Land thence Northwesterly bounding Westerly on the grantee's  
 Land thence Westerly and bounding southerly on the Grantee's Land to the  
 County road aforesaid thence Northwesterly bounding Westerly on the road  
 aforesaid to the first mentioned bounds. — To have and to hold  
 the afore granted Premises to the said Ariel Cook 2<sup>d</sup> his heirs and assigns  
 to his their use and behoof forever and I do for myself my heirs, Executors  
 and Administrators, covenant with the said Ariel Cook 2<sup>d</sup> his heirs and  
 Assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the afore granted premises;  
 that they are free of all Incumbrances: That I have good right to sell  
 and convey the same to the said Ariel Cook 2<sup>d</sup> and that I will warrant  
 and defend the same Premises to the said Ariel Cook 2<sup>d</sup> his heirs and  
 assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons  
 I do witness whereof, I the said Amariah Traft and Water Traft <sup>wife</sup> of the said  
 Amariah in relinquishment of all right to Dower or thirds in the above  
 described premises, have hereunto set our hands and seals this twenty seven  
 the day of September in the Year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred  
 and thirty four
