 tioned bound. at the Doctor's dam excepting and excluding from the above
 grant the rights of the public or of the town of Mendon in and to the
 roads passing through or upon the borders of the last described tract
 of land. — The two above described tracts of land are the same which
 are described in two deeds made to the late Seth Davenport and Seth
 Hastings one by Otis Ammidon recorded in said Registry Book
 156 Page 210, and the other by Stephen Ammidon recorded in said
 Registry Book 156 Page 212, to which deeds or the record thereof in
 said Registry reference is hereby made for a more particular description.
