

of the wall at a corner of Nathaniel George's land on the East side of the Worcester and Providence road thence running Northerly by and with said road (crossing the road leading from Mendon to Milford) till it comes to the corner of the wall at the head of Post lane so called. thence with said wall on the Southerly side of said Post lane North  $43\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  East fifty six rods and fifteen links thence with said wall North  $47^{\circ}$  East two rods and thirteen links thence with said wall North  $41^{\circ}$  East forty rods thence North  $32^{\circ}$  East eight rods thence North  $26^{\circ}$  East sixteen rods thirteen links thence North  $18\frac{1}{5}^{\circ}$  East three rods and ten links thence North  $9^{\circ}$  East six rods thence North  $35\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  East eleven rods and ten links the eight last lines bounding on said Post lane thence South  $74^{\circ}$  East eight rods and fifteen links thence South  $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East twelve rods thence South  $60\frac{1}{3}^{\circ}$  East thirteen rods and twelve links thence South  $88\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East twenty one rods thence Southeastly to the Milford road about nineteen rods the five last lines bounding by and with other land of the grantors which was conveyed to Seth Davenport and Seth Hastings by George Aldrich in part and in part by the town of Mendon thence Westerly by and with said road leading to Milford till it comes to a point opposite a corner of James Arnold's land thence crossing said road to said last mentioned corner and to a corner of a fence thence by and with said fence South forty four and an half degrees East twenty rods thence still with said fence South  $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East eleven rods thence South  $45^{\circ}$  West forty four rods and twelve links thence South  $49^{\circ}$  East twenty nine rods and eight links the two last lines running with the wall and fence are bounding on land of Waiter Davenport thence with the wall South  $41\frac{1}{3}^{\circ}$  West twenty eight rods thence with the wall South  $43\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  West twenty three rods and twenty one links thence still with the said wall South  $40^{\circ}$  West nineteen rods thence South  $41\frac{1}{3}^{\circ}$  West nine rods and ten links to the first mentioned bound on the East side of the Worcester and Providence road excepting and excluding the road leading from Milford to Mendon which passes through said tract and the Blacksmith's shop, hay scales and platform balance standing thereon with their appurtenances. — The second tract of land is situate on Pond hills so called and contains fifty six acres and forty two rods be the same more or less bounded as follows to wit beginning at a heap of stones at the Doctor's dam so called thence South  $10\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East passing over a stake and heap of stones twenty four rods to another stake and heap of stones thence South  $76\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West thirty six rods and five links to a corner of wall thence South  $70\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  West nine rods thence South  $72^{\circ}$  West three rods and four links thence North  $89^{\circ}$  West two rods thence South  $75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West fourteen rods thence South  $77\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  West three rods and sixteen links then South  $74^{\circ}$  West two rods and ten links thence South  $82\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West seven rods thence South  $86\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  West five rods and four links to a corner of a fence thence
