unto a certain tract of land and buildings thereon situated in the first
Parish in said Mendon being a farm containing One hundred & twelve
acres and twenty one rods be the same more or less & bounded as fol-
lows viz beginning on the West side of the Providence & Worcester road
at Adam Wheelock's land at a corner of a wall thence N 11° S 25 rods
to corner of Wall thence S 28° E 20 rods to corner of wall then W
11 3/4° S 33 rods & 4 links to corner of wall & bounding on said Wheel-
ock's land then S 6° W 33 1/2 rods to corner of wall then W 10° S 2
rods to corner of wall then S 20° E 23 rods to corner of wall these
last lines bound Westward on said Wheelock & H. A. Chisols land
then turning & running E 11° N 34 rods E 4 1/2° N 9 1/2 rods E 11°
N 13 rods E 8° N 8 rods E 11 3/4° N 20 3/4 rods to said road these
last lines bound Southward on Olive Darling's land then crossing said
road then E 10° N 5 rods N 32° W 1 rod then E 11° N 2 1/2 rods
then E 7 1/2° N 29 rods 3 links to Muddy Brook then S 23° E 6 rods
