


Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Know all men by these presents, that I Gilbert Greene of Clinton in the County of Worcester in consideration of two hundred dollars to me paid by Charles G. Stevens of Clinton aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give, grant sell and convey unto the said Charles G. Stevens and his heirs and assigns, a certain lot of land situate on the East side of Chestnut Street in said Clinton described as follows, viz. Beginning at a Stone bound in the ~~the~~ Eastern line of said Chestnut Street one hundred and fourteen feet Northerly of a Stone bound at the intersection of said line of Chestnut Street with the Northerly line of Church Street the Northwest corner of land of said Grantee conveyed to him by Horatio N. Bigelow by Deed recorded in the Registry of Deeds for the County of Worcester in Book 425, Page 188, and the Southwest corner of the lot, and running thence N. 25° 15' E. by said line of Chestnut Street fifteen feet to a Stone bound, thence S. 64° 45' E. about three hundred and twelve feet to a Stone bound in a line of land of Emory Harris' heirs, thence S. 22° 42' W. about fifteen feet to a Stone bound the Northeast corner of land so as aforesaid conveyed to said Grantee by Horatio N. Bigelow, thence N. 64° 45' W. three hundred twelve, 17/100 feet to the place of beginning with the reservation and restriction that no house, Shop, Barn, or other building shall ever be erected on said
