To have and to hold the before granted premises with all our right title interest and estate therein to him the said Winsor Mowry his heirs and assigns forever so that neither the said Welcome Cornstock nor Chloe Cornstock in her right nor their heirs or any other person claiming by from or under them shall or will by any way or means have claim or demand any right or title to the above quit claimed premises or to any part thereof forever.
