Know all men by these presents, that I Cyrus L. Daniel of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Boot Maker in consideration of Five Dollars paid by Mowry Darling of said Mendon in said County and Commonwealth Blacksmith the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do give grant sell and convey unto the said Mowry Darling his heirs and assigns the following described pieces of land situated in said Mendon and bounded as follows to wit. The first piece of land is bounded as follows. beginning at the Southwesterly corner on the Easterly side of the road leading from Providence to Worcester, thence running Southeasterly bounding Southerly by land of the grantee seven rods $2\frac{1}{2}$ links to a corner, thence North $28^{\circ} 30'$ East four rods 3 links to a stake and stones, bounding Easterly by land of the Grantor, thence North $28^{\circ} 30'$ West seven rods to said road bounding northerly by land of the Grantor, thence running Southerly bounding Westerly by said road to the point of beginning, containing twenty eight rods more or less. The second piece of land is bounded as follows beginning at the northeasterly corner on the Westerly side of the Providence and Worcester road thence North $58^{\circ} 42'$ West twenty two rods 19 links to land of the Grantee bounding Northerly by land of the Grantor, thence turning and running Southerly and Easterly by land of the Grantee to the said Providence and Worcester road, thence turning Northerly bounding Easterly by said road one rod 3 links to the point of beginning, containing sixty rods, more or less. The third piece of land is bounded as follows beginning at the Southeasterly corner, thence North $110^{\circ} 30'$ West twelve rods 20 links to stake and stones bounding by land of Grantor on the South, thence northerly bounding Westerly by land Grantor one rod 20 links to land of grantee thence running Easterly then Southerly by land of the Grantee to the point of beginning containing thirty rods more or less. To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Mowry Darling his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do for my self my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Mowry Darling
