the said Charles C. Chamberlin of the first part hereby sells
assigns transfers and conveys unto the said Henry H. Chamberlin
in consideration of one thousand Dollars by him paid all
the right title and interest which the said Charles C. Cha-
mberlin has in or unto all and any portion of the estate
formerly belonging to his father Harmon Chamberlin late
of said Worcester deceased and to the proceeds of the same
now in the possession of his Mother under and by virtue of
the provisions of the last Will and Testament of the said
Harmon Chamberlin to be held by the said Chamberlin the
party of the second part after the payment of the amount
which shall be due from the said Charles C. Chamberlin to
the said Henry H. Chamberlin in trust for the following purposes
viz. to be paid over by the said Henry H. Chamberlin for the
