To all persons to whom these presents shall come George Prentice of Blackstone in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts yeoman and Fanny Prentice wife of the said George Prentice send greeting: Know ye that in consideration of four hundred dollars to them paid by Winsor Morry of Mendon in said County yeoman the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said George Prentice and the said Fanny Prentice in the right of the said Fanny Prentice do by these presents grant remise release and forever quitclaim unto the said Winsor Morry his heirs and assigns all our right title interest and estate in and to the following described land and buildings thereon situated chiefly in said Mendon but a small part thereof in Uxbridge containing by estimation eighty three acres be the same more or less, bounded and described as follows to wit: Beginning at the Southwesterly corner thereof where an oak tree formerly stood at Samuel Gaffs land, thence running Northerly adjoining land of said Gaffs and land of Ezekiel Woods heirs as the fence stands till it comes to land of Perry Wood, thence turning and running Easterly adjoining said Perry Wood, thence turning Northerly a various line on said Perry Woods land till it comes to the old Cornpike Road, thence on said road Easterly till it comes to Perry Woods Land again, thence turning and running, & Easterly on said Perry Woods Land as the fence stands till it comes to said Woods watered lot, thence turning Southerly on said watered lot and continuing Southerly & Easterly adjoining the Thornton Farm as the fence stands till it comes to land of George Morry, thence Easterly adjoining said George Morry's Land and land of Jesse F. Alderman till it comes to the place of beginning: with the buildings thereon and the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, and is the same premises formerly belonging to Henry Morry, father of the said Fanny part of which he purchased of Ezekiel Morry by deed dated August 30th 1804 and the other part of Luke Aldrich May 3rd 1814.
