Young and land occupied by the Widow Mary Thayer, thence commencing on the Westerly side of said Providence and Worcester road at land occupied by said Widow Thayer, thence on said Widow Thayers as the same is now occupied till it comes to the Towns burying ground, thence on said burying ground till it comes to Gilbert Gaskell land, then Westerly, Southerly and easterly on said Gilbert Gaskell land to the old Rain, then on the Northerly side of said lane to said Providence & Worcester road, then commencing on the easterly side of said road at a corner of land formerly belonged to the Town of Mendon, then easterly till it comes to the other road, then Northerly on said road leading to said Williams till it comes opposite the place of beginning, not meaning to convey the roads included, any more than my right to them.
