 Alice Morris all men by these presents that we Bridget Reaves (former
 Stamp \$1.00 (cancelled) ly Bridget Ferguson) widow of Robert Ferguson, John Fer-
 guson, Thomas Ferguson, James Ferguson Robert Fergu-
 son, Leander Ferguson and Mary Jane Ferguson minor
 and children of said Robert Ferguson deceased all of
 Uxbridge in the County of Worcester in consideration
 of one dollar and the decree of the court in the above
 entitled cause paid by Alice Morris wife of Peter Mor-
 ris of Mendon in said County of Worcester the receipt
 whereof we do hereby acknowledge do hereby grant re-
 lease and forever quitclaim unto the said
 Alice Morris her heirs and assigns all our right
 title claim and demand in and unto a certain par-
 cel of real estate situated in said Mendon with the
 dwelling house and barn standing thereon, con-
 sisting of about one acre of land more or less, being
 the same real estate on which the said Alice Morris
 and Peter Morris have lived for some years and on
 which they do now live, and being the same real
 estate that was conveyed by P. P. Todd as assignee

 his deed to said Ferguson duly recorded in the
 Registry of Deeds for said County of Worcester will
 appear. And said Bridget Reaves having been ap-
 pointed Guardian "ad litem" for said John, Thomas,
 James, Robert, Leander and Mary Jane Ferguson,
 hereby joins in this conveyance releasing hereby
 to said Alice all the rights of her said wards in
 the above described premises. This conveyance
 is made in pursuance of the Decree of said Court in
 said above entitled cause. To have and

 and assigns to her and their use and behoof for-
 ever. And we do covenant to warrant and defend
 said granted and quitclaimed premises to the
