Aldrich Diana C. &c. Know all men by these presents, that we, Diana C. to Aldrich, widow, and Theodore W. Aldrich, both of Mendon in County Elizabeth C. Aldrich of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations paid by Elizabeth C. Aldrich, of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said Elizabeth C. Aldrich, all our right, title and interest in and to two certain tracts of land situate in said Mendon, the first being the same described in a deed from Luke Aldrich to Nathan C. Aldrich, dated the Fourteenth day of the second month, A.D. 1821, and recorded in the Registry of Deeds for Worcester County, Book 223, Page 193, and contains one hundred and thirty acres, more or less. The second being the same described in a deed from Amos & Chiron Aldrich to Nathan C. Aldrich, dated May 19<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1828, and recorded with said Worcester County Deeds, Book 266, Page 565, and contains twenty acres and seven rods. Said conveyed premises being conveyed subject to three mortgages, the first for one thousand dollars dated Dec. 8, A.D. 1874 from grantors and grantee to Samuel Gaskill, the second for one thousand dollars dated Jan. 12, A.D. 1875 from grantors and grantee to said Gaskill, the third for four hundred dollars, dated Dec. 20<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1879 from said grantors and grantee to said Gaskill, and these presents are upon the condition that said Diana C. Aldrich shall have a home in the dwelling house standing on herein conveyed premises, and shall have a comfortable support and maintenance, both home and support to be for and during her natural life. To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances
