

Shayer of Blackstone in said County and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Welcome A. Shayer, a certain tract of land situate in the central part of the town of Mendon, described in two certain deeds: The first from Luke Aldrich Jr. to Nathan C. Aldrich, dated Fourteenth day of second month A.D. 1821, and recorded with Worcester County Deeds Book 223, Page 193 describing a tract containing one hundred and thirty acres, more or less, situate on both sides of the road leading from the "Five Corners", so called, to the village of Mendon. The second from Anson Aldrich and Chiron Aldrich to Nathan Comstock Aldrich, dated May 19th, A.D. 1828 and recorded with Worcester County Deeds Book 266, Page 565, describing a tract containing twenty acres & 7 rods. Meaning hereby to convey all and the same premises described in said deeds, excepting a small tract of land on aforesaid road heretofore deeded by heirs of Nathan C. Aldrich to Nelson O. Smith known as old school house lot, excepting also such rights as the town of Mendon may have in and to the lot of land used for school house and lot on which the white school house now stands; also reserving to Willard S. Wilcox the right to cut and remove all standing or cut wood and timber from the lot on which the same is now lying or standing, which said wood and timber have been heretofore sold to said Wilcox at any time before the first day of May A.D. 1884, and subject to the taxes for the year 1883; also subject to three certain mortgages given to Samuel Gaskill, all amounting to about \$2400, which said mortgages and the notes and claims thereby secured, and all interest now due or which shall become due, the herein grantee assumes and agrees to pay as a consideration for these presents, and to save herein grantor harmless and indemnified from all loss, cost or damage for or on account of said mortgages, notes or either of them.
