Know all men by these presents that I, Hiram E. Cook of Southborough in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations to me paid by Lewis G. Wilson of Hopedale in said County and Commonwealth, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Lewis G. Wilson two certain tracts of land situate in the Southwesterly part of Mendon in said County and containing sixty seven acres more or less. The first parcel having a dwelling house and barn thereon is bounded, On the Westerly by the road running from the Village of Mendon to "Hordale Stand" and land of Heirs of Leon Daniels or others and land formerly of Gilbert Cook; Southerly by land of Heirs of Ann Scott, Easterly by Mill River and Northerly by land of said Gilbert Cook. The second parcel is bounded Easterly by the aforesaid road, Southerly by land of Heirs of said Ann Scott, Westerly by the "Eras-tus Hill pasture" and Northerly by land of Heirs of said Leon Daniels; and are the same premises conveyed to me by Leon Daniels and Susan More by their deed of Quitclaim dated May 8<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1884, and recorded in the Worcester District Registry of Deeds Book 1190 Page 121. This conveyance is made subject to the rights held by Deborah Daniels as the Widow of Cyrus Daniels or by the agreement of the Heirs of said Cyrus Daniels to the possession and enjoyment of certain parts of said premises during her lifetime. To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Lewis G. Wilson and his heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever. And I do hereby for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators covenant with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee-simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances except as aforesaid, that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. And for the consideration aforesaid I, Evelyn Cook wife of said Hiram E. Cook do hereby release unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both above and
