I, DENNIS P. RAINVILLE, of the Town of Franklin, County of
Norfolk and Commonwealth of Massachusetts,

hereinafter called the mortgagor,

in consideration of - - - - - THIRTY-FIVE HUNDRED and 00/100 (\$3500.00) - - - Dollars,
to me paid by the Woonsocket Institution for Savings, a corporation legally incorporated and transacting business in
Woonsocket in the County of Providence and State of Rhode Island, hereinafter called the mortgagee, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said mortgagee

A certain parcel of land together with all the buildings and other
improvements thereon, situated in the Town of Mendon, County of Worcester
and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, on the westerly and northwesterly side
of the road leading from Woonsocket, Rhode Island to said Town of Mendon,
