Worcester Jc. To all people who shall see these Presents Nathaniel Paine Judge of Probate of Wills &c within and for the County of Worcester in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Greeting -

Know ye that on the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of May A.D. 1788. The Instrument hereunto annexed for posting the last Will & Testament of Ebenezer Wheelock late of Melford in said County of Worcester Deceased was presented for Probate by Cyrus Wheelock the executor therein named then Present Doct Daniel Thurston and At Saml Hayward two of the witnesses thereto subscribed who made Oath that they saw the said Testator sign seal and heard him declare the said Instrument to be his last Will and Testament and that they with James Perry and Joseph Bates subscribed their names together as witnesses to the execution thereof in the said Testator's presence, and that he was then to the best of their judgment of sound disposing mind -

I do therefore Give approve and allow of the said Instrument as the last Will & Testament of said Deceased, and Commit the administration thereof in all matters the same concerning and of his estate whereof he died seized and possessed in Massachusetts with Cyrus Wheelock the before named executor well and faithfully to execute the said Will and to administer the estate of said Deceased according thereto, who aforesaid shall and hath given Bond accordingly to have, and he shall render an account of his proceedings when thereto lawfully required -

Well. The Year four A.D. 1786. I Nathan Verry of Melford in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Woman, being in good health and of perfect Mind and memory, thanks be given to God, therefore, best calling to mind the Weakness of my body and knowing that it is appointed for man here to Die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament, that is to say principally and first of all I give I commend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it hoping through the merits Death and passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have a full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit eternal life and my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the Discretion of my executors herein after named. nothing do I like and do not at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. - and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life and wherof I give Owen and dispose of the same in the following manner and form that is to say -

First I will that all my just Debts that I owe to any manner of person or persons what so ever shall be well and truly paid and discharged in convenient time after my Decease by my executors herein after named -

Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Wife Sarah Verry all and singular the sole use and improvement of all my homestead farm whome I now dwell to gether with the Muzzey lot so called, to be by her improved for her own use and benefit so long as she shall remain my widow, no wood nor timber to be cut on said Farm during said term but so much as is necessary for her own use in Building fences and firing, or said Farm (and after her Decease or marriage) to be divided between my two Daughters, Abigail Potine as shall be hereafter mentioned together with one equal half of all my in-door movables, to her sole use disposal and improvement also four cows out of my stock of cows, and one riding horse and thirty pounds in Cash -

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Nathan Verry Jr all and singular that Farm I purchased of Peter Thayer by two Cuds, one bearing date November 1<sup>st</sup> 1768 the other November 1<sup>st</sup> 1768 reference thereto being had both for bounds and Quantity to him the said Nathan Verry and to his eldest son lawfully begotten and so in succession to his eldest male heir succeeding from him the said Nathan Verry and in case he should Decease without any Male heir then to his eldest female heir and then to her eldest male heir and so in succession forever -

Also I give and bequeath to him the said Nathan his heirs and assigns forever all the land I purchased of Ephraim Spring by Deed, bearing date December 22<sup>nd</sup> 1777 reference thereto being had for bounds and Quantity - also all that Farm I bought of Henry Penman by Deed bearing date December 18<sup>th</sup> 1784 reference thereto being had for bounds & Quantity also one piece I purchased by Deed of Benoni & John Wenson dated December 26<sup>th</sup> 1782 also about twenty acres I purchased part of the estate of Seth Tappan & part of the estate of Thomas Darling Deceased of whom I had of the said Wenson the whole of the above said three pieces bequeathed once to the estate of Benjamin Darling late of Melford Deceased reference to the Cuds being had, and in case the said Nathan should Decease without any heir as above described then the whole of all the aforesaid premises to be equally divided between his two Sisters Abigail Potine and then to their eldest Male heir in succession forever - also all my farming tools and out door utensils of what name or Nature so ever -

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Abigail Verry one equal half of all my homestead farm together with one half of the Muzzey lot so called after the Decease or marriage of her Son Mother Sarah Verry (to whom I have given the improvement of during her remaining my widow) to her the said Abigail &
