chased of Elias Bailey viz all the land which was laid out by the  
Blackstone canal Company between Front street and the rail  
road bridge of the Boston and Worcester rail road except a small  
parcel upon the easterly side of said location and adjoining  
Front street which said Flagg quit claimed to Isaac Davis  
Aug. 11. 1849.
