Sullivan a certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situate in the easterly part of Mendon in said County of Worcester on both sides of the town road leading from the farm of the widow of Robert Allen to land formerly of Daniel Sayell and bounding northerly on land of the heirs of the wife of Sayman Cook deceased, easterly on land of the said heirs and land of one Saban Bates, southerly on land of Willard Whiston and westerly on land of one black Cook and land of the said heirs, there being on the northerly side of said road about ten acres and on the southerly side about fifty acres of land and being also a part of the farm known as the Dexter Thayer farm.
