 a mortgage deed given to Lucy M. Matthews as security for the pay-  
 ment of notes given by sd. John of \$5.00 and interest dated August 18  
 1873 which notes sd. Bunroe J. is to pay as the consideration first named  
 that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Bunroe  
 J. and that I will and my heirs shall warrant and defend the same  
 premises to the said Bunroe J. his heirs and assigns forever against  
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons except sd. mortgage deed.  
 And - Arvilla Tenney wife of the said John Tenney for the considera-  
 tion aforesaid do hereby release and quitclaim unto the said Bunroe  
 J. Tenney his heirs and assigns all the right title claim or demand  
 which she may have in and unto the premises hereby conveyed un-  
 der or by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the Commonwealth  
 of Massachusetts and also all right claim or possibility of dower in said  
 premises.
