Alexander to said Staples, dated May 30th A.D. 1874 recorded with Worcester County Deeds Book 928 Page 296 which deeds & records may be had for a more particular description of the above named premises.

To have and to hold the granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Amariah A. Taft and his heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever. And I do hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators covenant with the said Grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances except one mortgage of five hundred dollars on the last named tract of land that I have good right to let and convey the same as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons except as above. And for the consideration aforesaid I Harriet W. Staples wife of the said Edward L. Staples do hereby release unto the said Grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises.
