Gunn of Mendon, County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars paid by Mary Johnson of said Mendon, Widow, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mary Johnson a certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated in the South-westerly part of said Mendon on the Westerly side of the road leading from Albeville to Chestnut Hill in Blackstone, containing three fourths of an acre or the same more or less, and bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a point on said road at land formerly of Nevill N.
