Know all men by these presents, that I, Mary Johnson of Mendon, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of Four Hundred Dollars paid by Carl R. Olsen of said Mendon in said Commonwealth, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, Bargain, sell and convey unto the said Carl R. Olsen, a certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situated in the Southwesterly part of said Mendon on the Westerly side of the road leading from Alberville, so called, to Chestnut Hill, so called, in Blackstone, containing three-fourths of an acre, be the same more or less, and bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a point on said road at land formerly of the late Newell N. Taft; thence Westerly as the wall now stands to a corner at a ledge; thence Southerly as the fence now stands to a corner; thence still Southerly, and running as the wall now stands in a straight line to a corner; thence Easterly as the wall now stands to the aforesaid road; thence Northwesterly by and with said road to the place of beginning, the first three lines bounded on said Newell N. Taft's land. Being those same premises conveyed by Rachel S. Wheelock to Eva G. Gunn by deed dated June 18<sup>th</sup> 1895, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds. Said premises are sold subject to a mortgage thereof held by Henry W.
