I, Luther E. Taft, of Mendon, Worcester County, Massachusetts  
 being unmarried, for consideration paid, grant to Blanche L. Weston of  
 Pawtucket, in the State of Rhode Island, with **Q U I T C L A I M** cove-  
 nants a certain tract of land in said MENDON near the easterly shore of  
 Nipmuck Pond, so-called, bounded as follows: Beginning at a stone bound  
 at the southwesterly corner of the granted premises and the northwesterly  
 corner of grantee's present land, and at a roadway; thence N. 73° 50' E.  
 with grantee's present land, 100 feet to the northeasterly corner of said  
 grantee's land; thence N. 16° 10' W., bounding on grantor's other land,  
 50 feet to a stake at land of one Wilcox; thence S. 73° 50' W., with  
 said Wilcox land, 100 feet to a stake at said roadway; thence S. 16° 10'  
 E. with said roadway, 50 feet to the point of beginning; said last line  
 being a continuation northerly of the westerly line of grantee's present
