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I, Joseph C. Harrington, of Princeton, Worcester County, Massachusetts for consideration paid, grant to Krisis Slegeris of Gardner, in said County with W A R R A N T Y covenants all the trees standing and growing on the land hereinafter described, with full liberty and authority for the purchaser, his servants, agents and workmen from date until the 13th day of June, 1926, at all seasonable times to fell, cut down and remove said trees, doing the least possible injury to said land; with free ingress and egress with or without horses, oxen, wagons and carts into and upon said premises for the purpose of carrying away said trees. The land is described as follows:- A certain tract of land containing by estimation about 35 acres, located in said PRINCETON, on the westerly side of Wachusett Mountain and westerly from the road leading from Westminster to said Princeton, bounded and described as follows:- Beginning at the northerly abutment of a wall located westerly of a stone culvert, said abutment being at land formerly of John P.
